



REMEMBER IN NOVEMBER

We invite you to participate in our “*We’ll Remember in November*” fundraising drive for the Buffalo Niagara Partnership’s Political Action Committee – the Committee for Economic Growth. We are taking part in a multi-faceted, state-wide campaign to raise funds to aggressively support the employer community’s demand of Albany electeds to: **Reduce spending, reduce taxes and eliminate anti-business regulations.**

We’ve set a fundraising goal of \$100,000 for enacting change in Albany, specifically to be used to maintain voter anger and to get as many of those angry voters as possible to the polls to “Remember in November.” This fundraising effort is strategically high-profile – anyone running for any state office in 2010 running on an anti-business platform will see him or herself as a potential target of the funds we raise. Already, our recent announcement of this fundraising goal and extremely successful kick-off event has opened the eyes and ears of current electeds and their potential opponents.

In collaboration with our business organization partners in Unshackle Upstate and downstate, the Partnership is working to defeat the incumbents in targeted State Senate races. Our goal for this Election Day is an Upstate-friendly majority in the State Senate.

Why? We have enclosed a map that delineates the make-up of the State Senate under Republican and Democratic leadership. It’s scary that Upstate is so under-represented in the current alignment! As a direct result and particularly during the past year, actions by a New York City-centric state administration and legislature have been horrific. Worse, we will have long term horror if the upcoming post 2010 census redistricting is controlled completely by those same downstate electeds.

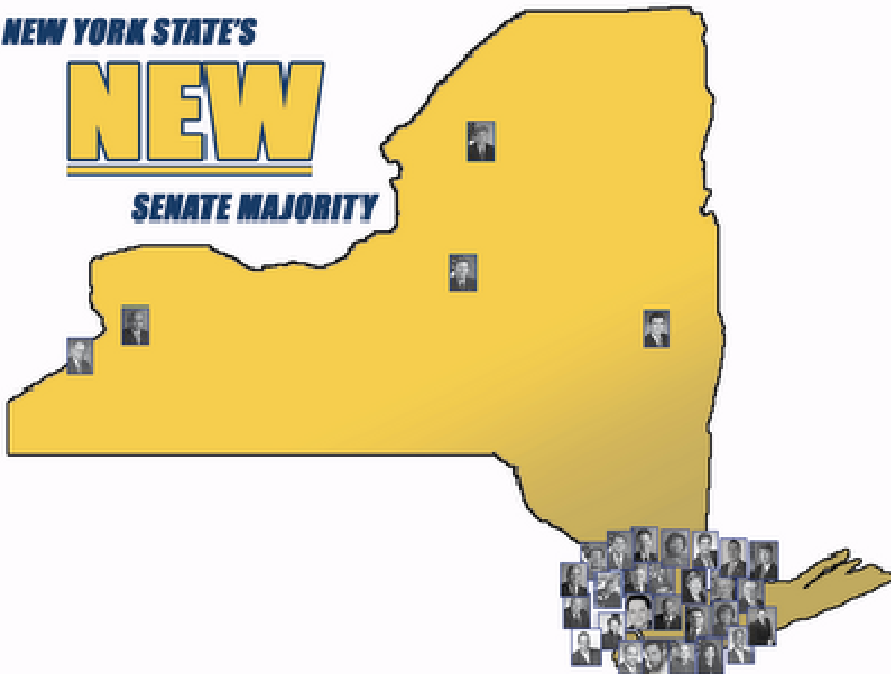
