## Expedited NEXUS Application Processing



*Avoid long lines and save time at the border by enrolling in the NEXUS program*

The NEXUS program allows pre-screened travelers expedited processing when entering the U.S. and Canada. Program members use dedicated processing lanes at designated northern border ports of entry.

### Member Application Process:

**STEP 1** ► Establish a [Global Online Enrollment System \(GOES\) Account](https://ttp.cbp.dhs.gov/) by visiting the enrollment website at <https://ttp.cbp.dhs.gov/>

You will need the following information to establish your account:

- Five years of address history
- Five years employment history
- ANY criminal history records, including approved rehabilitation information for Canadian residents
- ANY documents that will be used for admissibility into the U.S. and Canada
- Driver license information

**STEP 2** ► Complete your online NEXUS application

- Log into your GOES account and select "Start Application for Trusted Traveler Program"
- Select the link to the NEXUS application and follow the online instructions
- Pay applicable fees via online processing

**STEP 3** ► Monitor your application status

- Upon being "Conditionally Approved" for initial enrollment, send the following information to Moyla Halimy - Coordinator, Economic Development and Government Affairs at [mhalimy@thepartnership.org](mailto:mhalimy@thepartnership.org)
  - Name (Last, First)
  - Date of Birth
  - Membership Number – Can be found on the GOES application home page 24 hours after application submission
  - Business affiliation

**STEP 4** ► The Partnership will submit your information to U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP). CBP will then contact you within 7-10 days to schedule an in person interview at one of its enrollment centers

**STEP 5** ► Interview in-person with CBP

**STEP 6** ► Receive NEXUS enrollment upon confirmation by CBP
