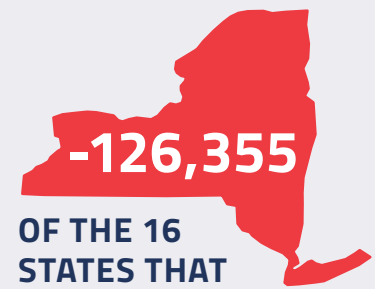
states. The tax burden on remaining residents will grow as more New Yorkers flee. As recent Census data demonstrated, we'll continue to lose representation in Washington.

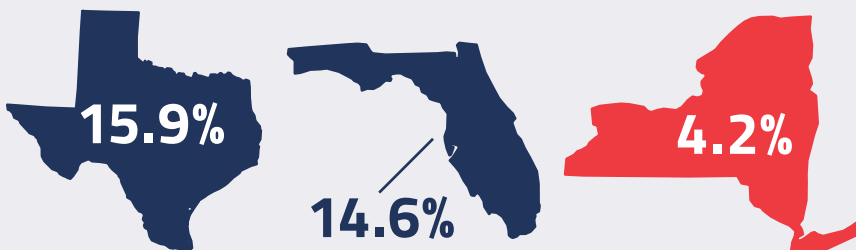
